Program Structure

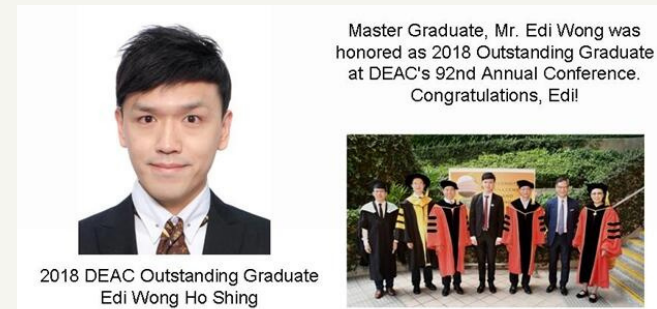
